The Fallen Warriors' Scholarship

Established by Andrew McLaughlin, Anna Ciaccio, and the Canton Community

Description: This award is given in memory of all fallen warriors by the Faculty of the Canton Jr. Sr. High School.

Purpose: The purpose of the Fallen Warriors' Fund is to provide an annual scholarship a high school senior in the Canton High School who is planning to pursue a college education.

Application Criteria: Applications will be accepted from any high school senior in the Canton Area School District who will be attending an accredited institution of higher education. Applicants must have a four-year cumulative grade point average of 90%, must be a curricular and co-curricular leader in his/her community and school, and must display honorable traits in his/her endeavors.

Application Process: An application can be obtained from the Canton Jr.-Sr. High School Guidance Office scholarship webpage. All applicants must submit a completed application form and one letter of reference.

Application Deadline & Address: Applications and essays must be returned to the Guidance Office no later than $A_{\rho(1)|5,25}$. Applications received after this date will <u>NOT</u> be considered.

Scholarship Selection Process: The Fallen Warriors' Scholarship Committee will review all applications and essays. The selection committee will consider evidence of involvement in community service, extra-curricular activities, and leadership positions held. Selections shall not be discriminatory on the basis of race, color, religion, creed, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, or similar characteristics of applicants.

Scholarship Awards: A scholarship award of \$500 will be awarded for the school year. Upon presentation of a 1st semester transcript, scholarships will be paid directly to the college or university where the recipient will be attending in the fall.
