MINUTES CANTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT FEBRUARY 11, 2021

The regular meeting of the Canton Area School District Board of Education was held virtually on Thursday, February 11, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Our President, Mrs. Judy Sourbeer, called the meeting to order, welcomed all in attendance, and reminded the audience to please sign in if they had not done so.

All stood and recited the Pledge to the Flag.

REPORTS

Superintendent

Dr. Eric Briggs, Superintendent, reported on the following items:

- PIAA has released a new form for all school districts to complete in order to participate in postseason play for our winter sports. This form has been added to the CASD athletic health and safety plan and we are seeking board approval this evening for this change. In essence, we need to agree to the health and safety face covering waiver should other student athletes participate in athletics without face coverings. Failure to participate in an event with an individual (or team) who does not wear a face covering for medical exemption reasoning cause our team to forfeit this match/game.
- Pennsylvania is still in phase 1A for vaccines, which includes about 3.5 million people. It will take more time to vaccinate those in Phase 1A before Phase 1B is activated. Educators are in Phase 1B. The Secretary did not have an estimate as to when the state will enter this phase of vaccination as the supply of vaccines has been limited. Pennsylvania only received 167,000 vaccines the week of February 1st. Pennsylvania received 175,000 vaccines this week and has been notified it will receive 175,000 vaccines the week of February 15th. (There are 12 million people in Pennsylvania.) They do not have information on the number of vaccines to be delivered to the state in subsequent weeks, which creates uncertainty in their planning process. The state will be notified by the federal government as to how many vaccines it will receive on a periodic basis. Pennsylvania Department of Health is expecting the vaccine supply to increase over time as the federal government increases production but has not received any definitive information as to when that will occur. The Department of Health will be providing weekly updates to keep us apprised of the vaccine process across the state.
- The CHS staff is currently participating in what we have named the "power to be seen" initiative improving connections between students and adult staff in the building. Through the beginning

phase of this initiative, we have identified students within the high school who we do not know as well as we could. As a result, we have developed a targeted list for our staff to begin forming connections with the students on that list. This initiative is ongoing and we continue to update our list on a bi-weekly basis.

- As voted on by our staff, the CHS Teacher of the Marking Period (2nd) was Angela Kelly. She spends countless hours helping students "recover" from long breaks both mentally and academically. Thanks for all you do, Angela!
- Early Intervention meetings were held today for our incoming kindergarten students. Kindergarten Registration will be held March 16-18.
- Mrs. Castle is currently working with her STEM team as they are preparing for a virtual competition this year.
- In place of Bocce Ball, we are participating in the Fitness Heptathlon under the auspices of Special Olympics Unified Sports. The Fitness Heptathlon offers participants a wide range of exercises best suited for their individual needs and interests. We have eight students (four athletes and four partners) that make up our team. Each picked two exercises from the three groups (Agility, Strength, and Endurance) and one more of their choice. Our team will be logging their performances and will compete with North Penn/Liberty and North Penn/Mansfield. Athens and Coudersport may participate as well. The competitions will be based on data collection and will not take place face-to-face. Helen Kilbourn and Maureen Martz are the coaches.
- Cindy Black, Teacher of the Gifted, has created a unit on renewable energy that allows students to explore, understand, and demonstrate how solar energy, hydropower, and wind power work. The rationale for the unit on renewable energy is to give these future leaders a better understanding of energy sources that do not have negative effects on our environment through hands-on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) challenges. The students will build a miniature wind turbine, a working hydropower water wheel, and build a solar powered car.

Business Manager
