The Arnot School of Nursing is a 2-year associate degree hospital based registered nurse program right here in Elmira on the ArnotHealth campus, and we are excited to be holding our first in person open houses since covid.

How do we do it:

We have room for only 30 students for the Fall 2024 semester. Our application is available on our website: www.arnothealthson.org. Our Deadline to apply for Fall 2024 is May 15, 2024. However, our acceptance is on a rolling basis, and we will start reviewing and accepting students for Fall 2024 beginning in January 2024 until our program is full. Please encourage interested students to apply as soon as possible. Students can be accepted into the program pending successful completion of the ATI TEAS test and successful graduation from high school. We do require passing the ATI TEAS test with a 65.7 % by May 15th. Information on the ATI TEAS can be found at: www.atitesting.com.

ArnotHealth, in an effort to help stem the nursing storage, is investing in sponsorships for Fall 2024. 



Basic Application Requirements

- Chemistry class w/ lab within past 5 years; 75% or better final grade.
- Algebra class 75% or better final grade
- ATI TEAS Test Score greater than or equal to current National Average, (65.7% currently)
- Completed and signed application form with the application fee
- A résumé and brief essay as outlined on the back of the application form
- Two references
- Official high school transcript regardless of graduation year.
- If applicable, Official college transcript(s) for ALL colleges attended regardless of date
- If applicable, submit a copy of GED scores and an official high school transcriptindicating successful completion of the required Chemistry and Algebra courses
- Practical Nurse (PN) Applicants must submit an <u>official/sealed</u> transcript from the PN nursing school and a copy of your current LPN license.
