# Carolyn Matthews Memorial Scholarship

The Carolyn Matthews Memorial Scholarship is a \$1,400 scholarship awarded to a high school senior based on his or her involvement with school and community service activities, character and academic record.

Carolyn was an editor at the Star-Gazette and wrote the award winning column, "Coping with Cancer," until her death in 1994 at the age of 29. She participated in community groups set up to help cancer patients cope with their disease.

One student is nominated per eligible school each year by their school counselor. Nominated students are instructed to log in and apply. One winner is chosen from the pool of submissions. You are receiving this insert because your school is eligible.

Special Factors: from the Twin Tiers (only one nominee per school) where the Star Gazette is distributed. A letter of recommendation from the School Counselor nominating the student must be included with the application. Nominees should be students who might not be the top scholar in the senior class but who have made a difference in their school, family and community. Past winners include students who have overcome enormous obstacles. Winners also have been students who have not faced personal obstacles but have been innovative and generous in donating time to their school, church and community.

In order to access the application, as the nominating School Counselor, you will instruct the student to apply through the web portal on our website at <a href="www.communityfund.org/students">www.communityfund.org/students</a>. Once logged in, the student must enter the code word "nomination" in the top right corner of the page. Once entered, the student will see the application appear.

It is important to note that your nominee is not guaranteed to win the award. One winner is selected from the applicant pool of nominees from all eligible schools. Winners will be contacted via email and school counselors will be notified if their nominee is selected.
