Pumpkin pie parfaits were a featured recipe for the month of November.















- Turkey gravy over biscuits served with mashed potatoes and apple crisp for dessert was on the menu.







Supply Chain Challenges



USDA's Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) is aware that schools/entities in multiple States are experiencing supply chain challenges related to half-pint cardboard milk packaging issues. To be clear, there is not a shortage of milk; the issue resides strictly with the cardboard packaging.

A significant industry supplier of the half-pint paper milk cartons is experiencing a shortage, which may impact dairy's ability to fully supply all orders. Unfortunately, this shortage spans nationwide and no other paper carton vendors have any excess capacity to assist in alleviating this issue. This shortage is likely to happen as soon as October 30th and we should see an improvement in supply by early 2024.

As Child Nutrition Program Sponsors, we are working with suppliers to obtain a solution while this shortage exists.
